Description of Tasks:

1. Knowledge of CNC machines, tooling requirements, set up and operation.
2. Basic knowledge of mathematics, trigonometry and geometry.
3. Basic understanding of general-purpose computer systems.

5. Ability to write simple programs to machine tooling, and/or soft jaws (absolute and incremental program mode).
6. Edit programs as required to improve efficiency, surface finish and/or errors in the program after approval from supervisor.
7. M.D.I. (Manual Data Input) offsets to maintain print tolerances along with a basic understanding of tool pressure and wear to maintain production requirements.
8. Thorough knowledge of tool holder styles and carbide grades.
9. Perform other duties as required to complete other tasks.
