
1. Scholarship program is open to High School Seniors who will be attending school in the fall after graduating from High School. There is no deferment or gap year provision.
2. Fill out the application for the scholarship award. Have it signed by the Principal or Guidance Director and return it to this office. **Include a college acceptance letter.**
3. Submit your Scholastic Aptitude Test or the ACT taken during the spring and/or fall of 2025, we will use the best out of the two SAT or ACT Scores.
4. Have your Principal or Guidance Director submit your school transcript to this office.
5. **It is your responsibility to make certain that these items are sent to this office.**
6. If for some reason you submit an application and did not take the Scholarship Aptitude Test or the ACT, please submit a letter explaining why. If you decide not to attend school after submitting your application, we would appreciate you notifying this office of your decision.

Applications must be received in this office before the deadline of March 31, 2026.

The winners will be selected by the Scholarship Committee of Teamsters Union Local 170 and the results of the competition will be announced to all candidates. In the event that we have not explained the procedures thoroughly and if you have any questions concerning the scholarship program, kindly contact this office and we will endeavor to answer any questions that you may have in respect to the scholarship award.
